Annual Plan for Procurement of Goods and Services from Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) in 2016-17

The Government of India, with a desire to encourage the small and marginal enterprises has promulgated the Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012. The public procurement policy rests upon the core principles of competitiveness, adhering to sound procurement policies and execution of orders for supply of goods and services in accordance with a system which is fair, equitable transparent, competitive and cost effective.

The policy envisages extending benefits/preferential treatment to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) and making efforts for development of appropriate vendors and enhancement of their participation in procurement.

As a schedule A CPSE under administrative control of the Ministry of Railways, RVNL is implementing the Public Procurement Policy diligently.

Mr. Ajay Kumar, Executive Director/HR, Corporate Office is the Nodal Officer.

To look into the problems faced by these enterprises and redress them effectively, a grievance cell is also working in RVNL. Mr. P.K. Sharma, General Manager, Project II, Corporate Office is the nominated Grievance Officer In-charge of the Grievance Cell.

RVNL has taken several steps for effective implementation of MSE policy. The benefits of waiver of cost of tender documents and deposit of earnest money, prescribed under the Policy, are incorporated in the tenders for stores procurement and obtaining services, etc.

As per the Public Procurement Policy for MSEs Order, 2012, all CPSEs are to mandatorily set an annual goal of procurement from Micro and Small Enterprises from financial year 2012-13 onwards with the objective of achieving an overall procurement of minimum of 20% of annual purchases of products and services rendered by Micro and Small Enterprises. Out of this 20% target of annual procurement from Micro and Small Enterprises, a sub target of 20% (which is 4% of total procurement) is to be procured from MSEs owned by SC/ST. In case of failure of SC/ST owned enterprises to meet the tender conditions and L-1 price, this sub target will be met from other Micro and Small Enterprises.

The expenditure on goods and services is planned to be approximately Rs. 8.50 crores (Rupees eight crores fifty lakhs only) in year 2016-17. This

expenditure is related to Printing & Stationery, Furniture and Fixtures, EDP Assets (Computer, Printers, Scanner, etc.), Office Equipment, Vehicle Hiring services, services of Manpower Outsourcing Agency, Security services, etc.

It is proposed to source goods and services worth Rs. 1.80 crore (Rupees one crore eighty lakhs) at least from MSEs in 2016-17 which is 21% procurement.

Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) are invited to participate in procurement of these goods and services.

MSE's owned by SC/ST are specially requested to participate in the procurement process.

For encouraging entrepreneurs to participate in the tendering process and procurements, vendor development programme will be organized during the year.
